MINUTES OF THE SPECIAL MEETING OF THE BOARDS OF DIRECTORS OF TURION METROPOLITAN DISTRICT NOS. 1-6

The Boards of Directors of the Turion Metropolitan District Nos. 1 – 6 held a special meeting via MS Teams and Teleconference on Wednesday, June 19, 2024, at 10:15 a.m.

ADMINISTRATIVE ITEMS

Declaration of Quorum/Call to Order: Ms. Skoglund noted that a quorum was present with three out of three Directors in attendance. The Special Meeting of the Boards of Directors (collectively, the “Boards”) of the Turion Metropolitan District Nos. 1-6 (collectively, the “District”) was called to order by Ms. Skoglund at 10:15 a.m.

Coordinated Meetings: The Boards determined to hold joint meetings of the Districts and to prepare joint minutes of actions taken by the Districts at such meetings. Unless otherwise noted below, the matters set forth below shall be deemed to be the actions of the Board of Directors of Turion Metropolitan District No. 1, with concurrence by the Boards of Directors of Turion Metropolitan District Nos. 2, 3, 4, 5 and 6, as applicable.

Director Qualifications/Disclosure of Potential Conflicts of Interest: All Board Members confirmed their qualifications to serve on the Boards. Ms. Early discussed the requirements of Colorado law to disclose any potential conflicts of interest or potential breaches of fiduciary duty of the Boards of Directors to the Secretary of State. The members of the Boards were requested to disclose any potential conflicts of interest regarding any matters scheduled for discussion at this meeting and incorporated for the record those applicable disclosures made by the Board members prior to this meeting in accordance with statute. It was noted by Ms. Early that disclosures of potential conflicts of interest were filed with the Secretary of State for all Directors.

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Approval of Agenda: The Boards considered the approval of the agenda. Following review and discussion, upon a motion duly made by Director Lenz, seconded by Director Eck, and upon vote, unanimously carried, it was
